Common Problems


This week we had discussions with two customers in very different industries, both facing the same issues:

- Onerous manual reporting tasks using spreadsheets to collate huge amounts of data from several cloud applications
- Restrictive hosting / storage services that limit number of user queries, overload database capacity, don't produce real-time data, and quickly ramp up costs

The Solution

Deploy a Business Intelligence tool that provides a holistic view of your data:

- Create a data warehouse and ingest your current data into it
- Use customised connectors to access all data from original sources
- Provide users with the ability to add and update data via BI tool forms



The upshot is...

spreadsheets will stay because they are quick and useful.
